### What was happening when Belstar was founded?

- On January 20, 1985, the San Francisco 49ers defeated the Miami Dolphins 38-16 at Stanford Stadium in Palo Alto, CA.
- U.S. President Ronald Reagan is privately sworn in for a second term in office on January 21, 1985.
- "We Are the World" is recorded on January 28, 1985 by USA for Africa in Hollywood, CA. The single goes on to win Record of The Year, Song of The Year and Best Pop Performance by a Duo or Group with Vocal at the 28<sup>th</sup> Annual GRAMMY Awards.
- Nelson Mandela rejects an offer of conditional release from the South African government on February 10, 1985. He releases a statement via his daughter, Zindzi, saying, "What freedom am I being offered while the organization of the people remains banned? Only free men can negotiate. A prisoner cannot enter into contracts." It will be five years and a day until he is officially released from prison, an event that will be broadcast live, all around the world.
- William J. Schroeder becomes the first artificial heart patient to leave the hospital on February 19, 1985.

### ACE Mentor Program

Belstar is a sponsor of the Architect, Construction and Engineering (ACE) Mentor Program of the Greater Metropolitan Washington Area, a nonprofit organization established by industry leaders in 1995 to provide mentoring, educational programming and scholarship opportunities for deserving students. The program has teams of volunteer mentors that go to area high schools to meet with students and conduct educational programs, encouraging students to consider careers in architecture, construction and engineering. The program currently has 18 active mentor teams and over 130 students participating in Northern Virginia, Maryland and DC.

ACE holds one major fundraiser, the ACE Annual Scholarship Breakfast, each year in order to raise critical funds for scholarships and program operation. Belstar would like to invite you to join the Board of the ACE Mentoring Program, along with hundreds of industry colleagues, at this year's event. The ACE Annual Scholarship Breakfast will be on **April 21**, **2010** in the **Historic Lobby of Terminal A at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport**. In order to determine the number and amount of awards, ACE Mentoring needs to confirm scholarship contributions and tables/seats to be purchased by each participating firm as soon as possible. Details concerning both methods of donation are as follows:

#### ACE Annual Scholarship Breakfast April 21, 2010

The cost of a table for 10 will be \$1500, and individual seats will be \$160. The proceeds will be used by the ACE to fund operation and mentoring program.

The available funding levels for combined table purchase/scholarship contributions will be:

### **Overhead Audit**

Belstar's 2009 audit was completed in March of 2010. Based on the previous year's audited rate at the date of the audit's completion, Belstar's project 2010 overhead rates (OH) for any new contract work started after April of 2010 are as follows:

Maryland Field OH - 100.63% Maryland Combined OH - 106.49% Virginia Field OH - 104.91% Virginia Combined OH - 110.50%

**Please note:** OH numbers are will be based on the numbers shown on the Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) and Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) audit divisions OH rate acceptance letters sent to Belstar. We anticipate receiving the respective MDOT and VDOT approval letters in the second quarter of 2010.
