National Mentoring Month

January was National Mentoring Month, a nationwide campaign dedicated to celebrating and promoting youth mentoring. Mentoring is one of the biggest ways Belstar gives back to the community, offering formal and informal mentoring of firms, as well as internship opportunities.

The goals of National Mentoring Month are to:

- Raise awareness of mentoring in its various forms;
- Recruit individuals to mentor, especially in programs that have waiting lists of young people; and,

Black History Month

February was Black History Month, a time to celebrate the lives and historic contributions of Black Americans. Black History Month was developed by Carter G. Woodson, who is known as the "Father of Black History." Woodson was born in Virginia, the son of parents who had been enslaved. The author and historian was also the second African American to earn a Ph.D. at Harvard University. He was quoted as saying, "Those who have no record of what their forebears have accomplished lose the inspiration which comes from the teaching of biography and history." Woodson believed it was of paramount importance for African American youth to know, understand and be proud of their heritage. Due to the lack of information in the American education system about the accomplishments of African Americans, Woodson founded the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History, now called the Association for the Study of African American Life and History (ASALH).

"The Black Family: Representation, Identity, and Diversity" was the theme of Black History Month 2021. This year, many institutions offered digital programming for those celebrating at home, such as the ASALH's Virtual Black History Month Festival. Content from this festival is still available online, here. The NAACP offered ideas for what brands could do to support Black History Month. Although the National Museum of African American History and Culture is temporarily closed due to COVID-19, virtual exhibits, online collections, digital resources and virtual events are available to celebrate and explore any time of year.

Women's History Month

The organization said, "The National Women's History Alliance is determined that the important roles of multicultural suffragists and voting rights activists continue to be recognized and honored. We refuse to allow their voices to be silenced, even by a pandemic."

ACE Mentor Program



Belstar is a sponsor of the Architecture, Construction and Engineering (ACE) Mentor Program of the Greater Washington Metropolitan Area. This program is now virtual, with students and mentor architects, engineers and contractors meeting for virtual sessions. These sessions can be attended via Chromebook, phone, tablet or PC, and include a brief introduction to an ACE topic, followed by

hands on activities and design challenges. Materials used for activities and challenges are common household items. Students may also join optional All Affiliate Webinars for virtual construction tours, sketch up tutorials and other engaging opportunities.

The ACE Mentor Program will celebrate the 2021 scholarship winners during a virtual event to be held May 19, 2021 at 8:00 AM. The event will include highlighting remarks from a keynote speaker.

During the first quarter of 2021, ACE DC has 15 teams doing virtual programming, and will be receiving scholarship applications until March 31, 2021. Two of the virtual teams are submitting projects for a national ACE competition. All teams are preparing for the Student Presentation Night, which will be held in May.
