### **Belstar Fourth Quarter Activities**

VTCA Hampton Roads District Dialogue was attended by Dan Belcher, Jr. on November 30 at The Landing at Hampton Marina.

The Hampton Roads dialogue was well attended, and the district continues to have a lot of work opportunities. There was a discussion about finding a way to relax some of the certifications to get work done. It was noted that the Virginia General Assembly is talking about changing some of the pay procedures for General Contractors. Finally, two attorneys recommended that the professional services industry take steps, in short, to be aware of this issue.

# VTCA Northern Virginia District Dialogue was attended by Hassan Kobrosli on November 2 at the Westin Washington Dulles Airport

This was a great opportunity to gather with our industry peers, Northern Virginia District Staff, and local leaders for education and networking at this year's Northern Virginia District Dialogue. The program included insight into VDOT's transportation program specific to the Northern Virginia district. NOVA District Engineer, John D. Lynch, led his staff through detailed presentations covering the district's construction, preliminary engineering, maintenance, operations, and mega project activities. VTCA's Gordon Dixon also shared timely details on VTCA's legislative activity in preparation for the 2023 General Assembly. Wrapping up the half-day program, in-person dialogues were attended during the themed lunch roundtables with VDOT and industry professionals.

In addition, the Project Controls Expo US was attended by Hassan Kobrosli in early October at Nationals Park.

This was a great opportunity to expand our global reach, and the inaugural event took

place in Washington, DC on 4-6 October 2022. The event had been tailored to meet local cultural requirements, and Washington, DC acted as a regional conference for North America, attracting participants from across the continent. Significant infrastructure projects are underway in this region, and it was a great opportunity to have an Expo delegate with excellent networking and a unique knowledge-sharing opportunity. International speakers and organizations have already expressed an interest in taking part in this exciting program in 2023.

Finally, Ozzie Belcher participated in the 2022 Foundations Program that was sponsored by Exelon and which was administered through the Capital Region and Eastern Minority Supplier Development Councils.

This was an executive-level program designed to familiarize participants with aspects of the utility business and to acquaint them on doing business with utilities. The meetings were held monthly from June through November with a closing ceremony on December 7, 2022.

The closing ceremony consisted of three parts. Part one was a brief presentation of key personnel from Exelon, CRMSDC, and EMSDC. Part two was a presentation by each participating firm summarizing their services, major projects, and lessons learned from being a participant in the Program. Part three was the presentation of certificates of completion.
