Black History Month

February was Black History Month, a time to honor the incredible contributions Black Americans have made throughout history. From artists to inventors, politicians to civil rights leaders, it is a time to acknowledge and celebrate past achievements as well the changes and history that are being made today.

An annual celebration of Black History was first conceived by Harvard-trained historian, Carter G. Woodson, during his travel to Chicago to take part in the 50 year celebration of the 13th Amendment's abolishment of slavery. That celebration inspired him, along with prominent minister, Jesse E. Moorland, to create the Association for the Study of Negro Life and History. From there, Negro History Week was founded and first celebrated

in 1926, and became Black History Month in 1976. February is the designated time for this acknowledgement and reflection as it is a month that contains the birthdays of both Frederick Douglass and Abraham Lincoln. Black History Month is now also observed in Canada, the United Kingdom and Ireland.

The theme for Black History Month 2023 is "Black Resistance", exploring how Black Americans have addressed historic and ongoing disadvantage and oppression. Despite inequitable social systems, Black Americans have found ways to advance, survive and thrive by innovating, lobbying, litigating, legislating and by helping one another as a community. These strategies have also served as a model for every other social movement in the United States.
