Fees average 20% for combined Office / 15% for Field Below similar-sized firms September 15 through October 15 is National Hispanic Heritage Month. The 2023 theme is, "Latinos: Driving Prosperity, Power, and Progress in America." This celebration recognizes the Latinx and Hispanic communities, as well as the individuals that comprise those communities, which play a significant role in driving prosperity, power, and progress in the United States and the world.

Hispanic Heritage Month began as Hispanic Heritage Week in 1968 under President Lyndon B. Johnson. Although Representative Esteban Torres of California attempted to extend the observance to one month in 1987, it took until 1988, when Senator Paul Simon of Illinois submitted a similar bill, which was eventually signed into law on August 17, 1988 by President Ronald Reagan. September 15 was chosen as the kickoff for the commemoration as it coincides with Independence Day in Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. In addition, Mexico celebrates Independence Day on September 16, Chile celebrates on September 18, and Belize celebrates on September 21st. Also falling within this 30day time period is Día de la Raza, celebrated in Mexico on October 12.

For more information about this observance, the National Museum of the American Latino has <u>bilingual resources</u>. The Library of Congress, National Archives and Records Administration, National Endowment for the Humanities, National Gallery of Art, National Park Service, Smithsonian Institution, and U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum, also have resources including <u>exhibits and collections</u>, <u>videos</u>, and <u>events</u>. You can also check out this <u>Tedx Talk</u>, discussing what it means to be Hispanic and Latinx in the United States.

The Scholarship Breakfast honors scholarship recipients, provides networking opportunities and is a celebration of the incredible work of the architectural, construction and engineering industries.

ACE DC celebrated this year's scholarship recipients, the tireless dedication of their mentors, and another successful program year, on April 26, 2023 at the Mayflower Hotel in Washington, DC. With over 200 people in attendance, the keynote speaker was Emily Grandstaff-Rice (FAIA) President, The American Institute of Architects, and over \$100,000 was raised. The scholarship award amount was increased this year to \$5,000 per student, and 13 scholarships were awarded: nine to high school seniors and four to college alumni who were ACE participants while in high school. This year, the ACE program had 85 mentors throughout the region who met after school to engage with over 180 high school students.



ACE DC was established in 2000. It has mentored 2100 DC-area students and distributed 25 scholarships worth more than \$800,000.

Belstar recently celebrated their 20 year "Sponsor-versary" of partnering with the Compassion organization to help make a positive impact on the lives of Carline and now Richica.


Richica
