During this time we are reminded of the vibrant and diverse Hispanic and Latino histories, stories, and traditions woven into the the fabric of the United States. The 2024 theme is, "Pioneers of Change: Shaping the Future Together."

This celebration begins on September 15 as this day is of great significance, marking the independence anniversaries of Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. Belize, Chile, and Mexico closely follow commemorating their independence on September 21, September 18, and September 16. Día de la Raza, celebrated in Mexico on October 12, also falls within these 30 days.

Beginning as Hispanic Heritage Week in 1968 under President Lyndon B. Johnson, Representative Esteban Torres of California attempted to extend the observance to one month in 1987. However, it took until 1988, when Senator Paul Simon of Illinois submitted a similar bill, which was eventually signed into law on August 17, 1988, by President Ronald Reagan.


Belstar recently celebrated their 20 year "Sponsor-versary" of partnering with the Compassion organization to help make a positive impact on the lives of Carline and now Richica.
