Established in 2002 by MENTOR, a non-profit organization focused on expanding opportunities for young people by building a youth mentoring field and movement, and the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health, this monthlong campaign encourages organizations and individuals to get involved and highlights the positive impact that mentoring relationships have on young people.

This year, National Mentoring Month continued its mission of expanding access to mentorship opportunities, advocating for the importance of guidance and support in personal and professional growth, and fostering meaningful connections. Key dates included:

- January 11 I Am a Mentor Day, celebrating mentors and their contributions
- January 17 International Mentoring Day, honoring the global impact of mentorship
- January 25 Thank Your Mentor Day, a day to show appreciation to mentors

Mentoring plays a big role in how Belstar gives back to the community by offering formal and informal mentoring of firms and internship opportunities. ## **Black History Month**

February was Black History Month, an annual celebration of the achievements, contributions, and history of African Americans in the United States and beyond. It is a time to reflect on the triumphs, culture, and struggles of African Americans throughout history. This observance began as Negro History Week in 1926, founded by Harvard-trained historian <u>Carter G. Woodson</u>, and the Association for the Study of African American Life and History. The second week of February was chosen as the time to celebrate as it coincides with the birthdays of Frederick Douglass and Abraham Lincoln. In 1976, President Gerald Ford expanded the observance to a full month and officially recognized it as a time to honor Black history.

The Black History Month theme for 2025 is "African Americans and Labor" focusing on the profound ways that work of all kinds intersects with the collective experience of Black Americans. The National Museum of African American History and Culture's exhibit,

"Invisible Changemakers of Industry" highlights people such as <u>Elizabeth Keckley</u>, an enslaved seamstress who became the personal dressmaker of Mary Todd Lincoln. "With my needle, I kept bread in the mouths of seventeen persons for two years and five months," said Keckley, who eventually bought her way out of slavery and eventually owned a shop in Washington, D.C. There is also the exhibit, "<u>Making A Way Out Of No Way</u>" exploring the ways that Black Americans created ways to serve and strengthen their communities through education, religious institutions, businesses, the press, and organizations.

## Women's History Month



March is Women's History Month and the 2025 theme is "Moving Forward Together! Women Educating & Inspiring Generations." This theme celebrates the collective strength and influence women who have dedicated their lives to leadership, mentorship, and education have had on past and present generations. During this time, we recognize the vital roles women have played in shaping society, from arts and activism to science and politics.

First observed in 1911 as International Women's Day, Women's History Month gained greater recognition in the late 20th century. President Jimmy Carter declared the week of March 8 as National Women's History Week in 1980. By 1987, advocacy by organizations like the National Women's History Alliance led to the expansion of the celebration to the entire month of March.


